Children's Developmental Center Fact Sheet

OUR MISSION:

The Grace Hill Children's Developmental Center (CDC) was established in 1996 to offer parents and guardians a place where children in their care can receive help for emotional, behavioral and developmental issues. The CDC provides a team of specialists to evaluate and treat the medical, psychological, and social needs of the child. Because each child's world involves home and school, the CDC works with both parents and the school system to help manage developmental, behavioral or emotional problems that may be affecting the child. The CDC provides individualized assessments and treatment, which may include individual, family, and/or group therapy.

OUR GOAL:

The CDC seeks to improve social, developmental, mental health, and general health outcomes for children, from infancy to high school. We believe in a partnership between health professionals, the child, the family, and the school to promote the healthy development of each and every child we serve.

OUR TEAM OF PROFESSIONALS:

The CDC has numerous professionals that work together to manage the concerns and problems faced by each family that we serve. Our team consists of:

- ~ Developmental Pediatrician
- ~ Pediatric Neurologist
- ~ Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist
- ~ Child Psychologists
- ~ Licensed Clinical Social Workers

The Center collaborates with St. Louis Children's Hospital, Washington University School of Medicine, and the child's Pediatrician.

In addition the Center has established a Law Clinic, in collaboration with both the St. Louis University Law School and the Washington University Law School, to help parents with legal issues that may have to be addressed, such as specific educational interventions that may be necessary for their child's academic success.

TYPICAL ISSUES SEEN AT THE CDC

The following is a list of behaviors that our parents describe as causing them the most difficulty, give them the most stress and are their biggest concerns:

- ~ She can't sit still – is always "on the go."
- ~ Teacher says my child is behind in school work.
- ~ My child is very aggressive and physical.
- ~ He is smart, but has school problems.
- ~ Doesn't seem to listen.
- ~ She just acts a little "strange" – like she repeats things, doesn't look at people.
- ~ Cries a lot and seems to be very moody.
- ~ Always has to have the last word.
- ~ Doesn't talk and /or has speech problems.
- ~ Seems to be a slow learner.
- ~ Is very anxious or depressed.
- ~ He has a lot of difficulty playing with other kids.

There can be numerous reasons for these behaviors. Our purpose is to help parents and their child understand the causes and obtain the right treatment.

OUR SERVICES:

To ensure early recognition and intervention for specific neurological and/or behavioral or emotional problems, the CDC provides the following services:

- ~ Neurological Examinations
- ~ Developmental Assessments
- ~ Psychological Evaluations
- ~ Psychosocial Assessments
- ~ Individual and Family Counseling
- ~ Case Management
- ~ Resource Development and Linkages
- ~ Management of Neurological and Psychiatric Conditions (Including Pharmacologic treatment)
- ~ Initial assessment process usually occurs within 48 hours of referral
