Grace Hill Neighborhood Health Centers (GHNHC) provides low-cost, primary and preventive health care at six locations in the City of St. Louis. In 2009, GHNHC provided health services to more than 41,000 individual patients. Nearly 60 percent, had no health insurance and more than 90 percent are under 100 percent of the federal poverty level. A "safety net" for those in need of health care, our patients are primarily uninsured and underserved residents of St. Louis and surrounding communities.
