Grace Hill Neighborhood Health Centers, Inc. (GHNHC) has been enabling healthy, productive lives for more than 100 years. We are a non-profit, federally qualified health center. GHNHC is accredited through the prestigious Joint Commission.



A Brief History

GHNHC was originally part of the mission work of Holy Cross House. Called Holy Cross Dispensary, we were founded to treat people battling alcoholism. Realizing the great need for health care for the many immigrants living in the area, the volunteer providers and leaders in the Episcopal Church suggested that the community would be better served by a health center offering expanded services.

GHNHC has grown to provide primary and preventive health care at six locations to more than 41,000 patients annually. Our patients are primarily uninsured and underserved residents of St. Louis and surrounding communities.



Our Services

Trusted health care is provided by highly-qualified and dedicated professionals at each of our locations. These providers, working alongside our other dedicated staff and volunteers at GHNHC, have received their training and certifications from some of the best programs in the nation.

Services include primary medical and dental care, podiatry, OB/GYN, pediatrics, internal medicine, behavioral health, pharmacy, and other specialties. Our community health nurses and medical assistants provide a variety of care to high-risk pregnant mothers and babies. **A complete list of our services is located on the other side of this brochure.**

Our Sliding Fee Scale

GHNHC offers a sliding fee scale that is based on household income. Patients who apply and are eligible will pay a reduced fee. Proof of income is required. Co-pay amounts are due at the time of service.

INSURANCE PLANS ACCEPTED AT GRACE HILL:

Medicaid:
Health Care USA; Molina; Harmony; Missouri Care, an Aetna Health Plan; as well as traditional Medicaid. These plans are accepted for most GHNHC Services, such as Medical, Dental, the CDC, and Pharmacy.

Medicare:
Traditional Medicare accepted for most GHNHC services. GHP Advantra – accepted for Medical and Pharmacy Services Only.

Medicare Part D plans accepted for Pharmacy:
WellCare; Caremark; First Health Premier Rx; GHP Advantra Rx

Some commercial plans are accepted:
Essex (for dental only), BlueCross/BlueShield MO (Alliance/Alliance Choice plans only), and other plans.
